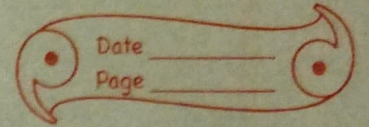

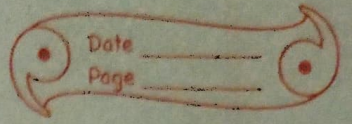
THE MAN AND THE WOOD
