Ans) Powers of the President are

- All govt. activities take place in the name of the President.
- All laws and major policy decisions of the govt. are issued in her name.
- All major appointments are made in the name of the President (Such as the appointment of the Chief Justice of India, the Judges of the Supreme Court & the High Courts of the States, the Governor of the States, the Election Commissioners, ambassadors to other countries etc).
- All international treaties and agreements are made in the name of the President.
- The President is the supreme commander of the defence forces of India.
