Q. Narrate the reasons for 1905 Revolution in Russia. (or causes of the revolution of 1905 in Russia)

Ans) Reasons for 1905 Revolution in Russia are

- Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined by 30 percent.
- When four members of the Assembly of Russian workers, were dismissed at the Putilov Iron works, there was a call for industrial action.
- Over the next few days over 110,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to eight hours, an increase in wages and improvement in working conditions.
- When the procession of workers led by the Father Gapon reached the winter Palace it was attacked by the police and the Cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed and about 300 wounded, which came to known as Bloody Sunday.
- All the people from different parts of the country joined in the strike like doctors, lawyers, engineers, students, teachers etc.
