

Therefore, 1 represents 1 bead and 0 has one bead, 10 has 1 bead and 0 has 2 beads. Therefore, 1 represents 1 bead and 0 has 2 beads.

- Note**
1. Please explain to the children that an abacus has spikes to represent numbers and beads to represent the value.
  2. Each spike is an abacus and it is represented by 1 bead in spike. We know that one more than 9 is 10 and it is represented by 1 bead in spike. Also one more than 99 is 100 and it is represented by 1 bead in spike.
