

Q1. Write a detailed note on the nature of town planning in the Indus cities.

ans- The most striking feature of Indus valley civilisation was its well-planned ~~and~~ nature of its cities. Cities of this civilisation show that people had good knowledge of town planning.

- The cities were divided into two parts. One part was at a higher level, it was built on a massive platform of baked bricks. The archeologist called this area acropolis or citadel. It is surrounded by huge walls.
- The lower part of the city consisted of the houses of the common people.
- The town planners of those time made straight roads crossing each other at a right angle and thus dividing the city into blocks.
