① Describe the powers of president?

Ans) The powers of president are :-

- All government activities take place in the name of the president
- All laws & major policies, decisions of the government are issued in her name
- All major appointments are made in the name of the president. These include the appointment of the Chief Justice of India, the Judges of the Supreme Court & High Court of the State,
- All international treaties & agreements are made in the name of president
- The president is the Supreme Commander of the defence forces of India.
