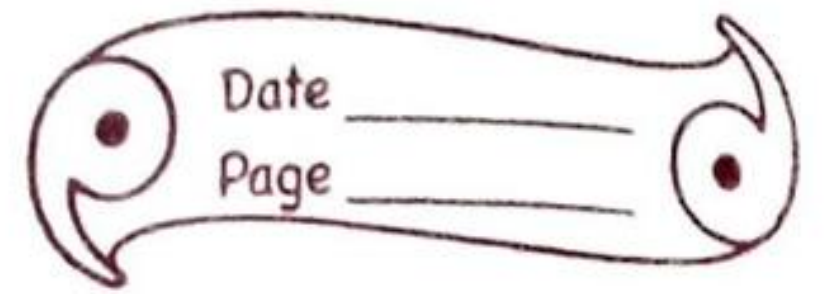

1) Where the term Brahmaputra originates?

Ans) The Brahmaputra rises in Tibet east of Mansarovar lake very close to the sources of the Indus & the Satluj.

3) What does the Brahmaputra do in Namcha Barwa?

Ans) It takes a U-turn & enters India in Arunachal Pradesh through a gorge. Here it is called the Dihang & it is joined by the Dibang, the Lohit & many other tributaries to form the Brahmaputra in Assam.
