4) Result of 1905 Revolution was that the Tsar allowed the creation of an elected consultative parliament.

1) Reasons are:-

- The year 1904 was a particularly bad one for Russian workers. Prices of essential goods rose quickly that real wages declined by 20%.



- The membership of worker's association rose dramatically.
- Over the next few days over 110,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in working day & night and improvement in working conditions.
- When the procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the Winter Palace it was attacked by the police and the cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed and about 300 wounded. The incident, known as Bloody Sunday started a series of events that became known as 1905 Revolution.
