ans The Peace Treaty at Versailles with Allies was a harsh and humiliating peace because Germany ~~was~~ forced a huge loss and these were:—

1. Germany lost its overseas colonies, a tenth of its population, 13% of its territories, 75% of its iron and 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark and Lithuania.
2. The Allied powers demilitarized Germany to weaken its power.
3. The War Guilt Clause held Germany responsible for the war and damages the Allied countries suffered.
