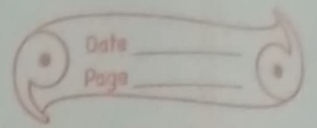

- \* should not hold any salaried government job

3. Mention the important powers of speaker of Lok Sabha?

- \* maintain discipline in the Lok Sabha
- \* certifies money bills
- \* may cast his or her vote to resolve the deadlock if there is a tie after voting.
